



2019 Youth & Girls Golf Skill Levels

Early Starters: This is a parent/child class for 3-5 year olds offered twice per month on Saturday afternoons. Basic instruction with lots of cheering and a focus on FUN.

Level I: For kids 6 years and up whom have not had any formal golf instruction. Focus is on basic fun-da-mentals. To graduate, kids must earn all 5 Level I curriculum pins & submit required scores. This is not a class for the older beginning player. Please contact Dona Lerner at practicetee@aol.com to discuss options for these young players.

Level II: For kids who have completed Level I and have earned all 5 curriculum pins, or have had basic instruction and pass the evaluation tests. This class focuses on fundamentals & swing technique as well intro to appropriate etiquette and basic rules. To graduate, kids must earn all 5 Level II curriculum pins & submit required scores.

All new students wishing to be assigned to Levels 3-5 will take a skills assessment to determine appropriate skill level at which to start. This is a 30-min evaluation

Level III: For those who have competed and graduated from Level II. This class will reinforce Levels I & II and introduce specific swing technique and on-course play. To graduate, kids must earn all 5 Level III curriculum pins & submit required scores.

Level IV: For kids preparing to play in HS or competitive golf who can pass the curriculum tests for Levels I, II & III. This is a fun class that will teach sho

t selection, mental game development, course management, skill enhancement & practice routines. Much of this class will be on the golf course.

Level V: This class is for those young players who are already or preparing to compete in High School. Participants in this class are chosen by the instructional staff because of their mastery levels, commitment to improve and coachability. Much of this class will be taught on the course and will be playing situation oriented. We will also focus on swing/shot development.
